

## **Free Bus Passes for March 2010**



Community Action has a limited number of free Topeka Transit bus passes good for the month of March. Passes will be available starting March 1, 2010.

To qualify, applicants must be 18 years or older, who depend on public transportation to travel to and from their employment, or vocational training

site.

In addition, applicants must meet income guidelines set at or below, 200% of the Federal income guidelines (ex. family of 3, \$36,620; family of 4, \$44,100). To check income eligibility, go to this website's homepage, find "About Community Action" at the navigation bar and click on "Program Income Guidelines."

Because of a limited supply, applicants must call Community Action's Swygart Center at 785-235-9296 to check on availability. Bus passes will be distributed on a first-come-first-served basis. Applicants will be required to provide proof of current employment or vocational training, household income for the past 30 days, and Social Security numbers for all household members. Applicants must also complete the agency Consumer Intake Form and provide a picture ID.

Applications are being taken at Community Action's Swygart Center, 621 SE Swygart, Topeka. One bus pass may be acquired every six months, as long as the supply lasts.
