

Free Food Distributions for November 2011



Because of Thanksgiving changes have been made to the free food distribution schedules in Auburn and Rossville, KS.

The Auburn food distribution will be from 1 - 2 p.m. on Friday, November 18 at the Auburn Community Center, 121 W. 11th.

The Rossville food distribution will be from 12:30 - 1:30 p.m. on Wednesday, November 23 at Citizen Potawatomi Nation,

806 Nishnabe Trail. Nishnabe Trail is just southeast of Rossville off of US Hwy 24.

Rural Mobile Food Pantry Distribution by Community Action, Inc. and Harvesters Food Network will distribute fresh food, fruits and vegetables, and dry goods on a first-come, first-serve basis. There are no income guidelines to receive the food. However, you must provide a picture ID and social security number. Please bring a box, cart or sturdy bag to transport the food.

Times and dates for the December 2011 distributions have yet to be determined.
