

Free Food Distributions for December 2011 through March 2012



The Auburn, KS free food distributions will be suspended from December 2011 through March 2012.

However, the Rossville, KS food distributions will continue to be held from 12:30 - 1:30 p.m. on the fourth Wednesday of each month at Citizen Potawatomi Nation, 806 Nishnabe Trail. Nishnabe Trail is just southeast of Rossville off of US Hwy 24. The December distribution will occur on December 28.

Rural Mobile Food Pantry Distribution by Community Action, Inc. and Harvesters Food Network distributes fresh food, fruits and vegetables, and dry goods on a first-come, first-served basis. There are no income guidelines to receive the food. However, you must provide a picture ID and social security number. Please bring a box, cart or sturdy bag to transport the food.

Also, food pantry items now are available each Monday at Community Action's Swygart Center, 621 SE Swygart, on a first-come, first-served basis until the items are gone.
