The Auburn (KS) Rural Mobile Food Pantry will be held on the fourth Friday of each month from 1 - 2 p.m. at the Auburn Community Center, 121 West 11th in Auburn, KS. 121 West 11th is near SW 89th and Auburn Rd. in southwest Shawnee county.

The Rossville (KS) Rural Mobile Food Pantry will be held on the fourth Wednesday of each month from 12:30 - 1:30 p.m. at Citizen Potawatomi Nation, 806

Nishnabe Trail in Rossville, KS. Nishnabe Trail is just southeast of Rossville off of US Hwy 24 in northwest Shawnee County.

Rural Mobile Food Pantry Distribution by Community Action, Inc. and Harvesters Food Network will distribute fresh food, fruits and vegetables, and dry goods on a first-come, first-serve basis. There are no income guidelines to receive the food. Please bring a box, cart or sturdy bag to transport the food.
