Community Action, Inc. provides annual scholarship opportunities to adults and graduating high school seniors seeking financial assistance to support college, vocational-technical, or trade school education ventures. The deadline for submitting applications for 2011 scholarships was May 13. When information on 2012 scholarships becomes available, it will be posted at this website.

To qualify applicants must demonstrate a financial need and be residents of Clay, Dickinson, Geary, McPherson, Ottawa, Riley, Saline, Shawnee, or Wabaunsee counties. Scholarship funds may be used for expenses such as tuition, books, child care, and tools.

Both traditional students (defined as students who are graduating high school seniors or home-schooled students who have successfully completed required Kansas Department of Education coursework or received a GED) and non-traditional students (defined as students who have been out of high school for a period of twelve months or longer and have a high school diploma or GED) are eligible.

The agency's Board of Directors is responsible for determining the number and dollar amount of scholarships that will be awarded each year. Two \$1,000 scholarships were available in 2011.
